The outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Text: Acts 2:1-13

The children learn what happened fifty days after Jesus Christ's resurrection, and why we still celebrate Pentecost. They rejoice that God is active through the Holy Spirit.

Ten days after Jesus Christ's ascension, God sent the promised Comforter to those waiting in Jerusalem. The power of the Holy Spirit filled them and impelled them to profess themselves to Jesus Christ. To the amazement of all present, they were understood by people who spoke a great variety of languages.
