EXERCISE 1



The parable of the foolish rich man

Luke 12:13-21

Jesus answered him by saying that He was no judge or arbitrator. He warned His disciples and the people against greed, saying, "One's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions." Then He told the parable of the foolish rich man.

## Read the text and complete it with the help of the Bible.


There was a rich man whose fields had brought a good yield. So he thought about how he would store the harvest because he did not have enough room for so much produce.
