| | 2.1: An ideal time preferably to present the lesson is after the Sunday morning service in line with the normal Sunday School time to maintain the routine. |
| | 2.2. Please keep the lesson as concise as possible, bearing in mind the retention span (to focus on the lesson) of our children you know your child best. Sunday School normally does not exceed 45 minutes. |
| | 2.3: The lessons are class specific (i.e. SS, RI, or Confirmation). |
| | 2.4: Please contact your SS teacher if you need any of the above resources. |
| 3. | Pray (see the prayer at the end of this document) and ask God to use you as a tool to present the lesson the way He would want us to present it. |

How to prepare and present the lesson

We continue to share some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

| Step | Action |
|------|--|
| 4. | Create a pleasant (disturbance free) learning environment where you and the children are at the same level |
| | Example: Sit on the mat or at a table |
| 5. | Read through the lesson. Re-read the lesson so that you understand it. Watch the video clip of the lesson to get a better understanding of the lesson. |
| 6. | Make notes for yourself on important points that you would like to remember. |
| 7. | Understand the objective of the lesson that your child must remember. |
| 8. | Present the lesson to your child by telling the story. You can even read the story if you like. |
| 9. | Show your child the video and recap on the meaning/purpose of the lesson. |
| 10. | Refer your child to the activity in the child's workbook. |
| 11. | Pray, or ask your child to pray and close the lesson. |

The Lesson

Lesson Title

Fulfilment of the promise - taking possession of Canaan

Text

Numbers 27: 18 - 27; Deuteronomy 34 and Joshua 3 - 12

Lesson Objective

The children learn that God will fulfil His promise.

Lesson Summary:

- At the end of the forty-year journey in the desert of the Israelites, God said to Moses that He will not enter the Promised Land and that he would die soon.
- Moses asked God to choose a new leader for the people and God chose
 Joshua. Moses then introduced Joshua to Eleazar and the people, he then laid
 hands upon Joshua and appointed him as the new leader.
- He reminded the Israelites of their experiences during their journey and encouraged them to obey the Lord's commandments and laws. The Lord will continue to be with them. Moses asked everyone to follow Joshua and to continue trusting in God, who will help them take possession of the Promised Land.
- God led Moses up to the peak of Mount Nebo and allowed him to see the Promised Land. Moses died and was buried on the mountain.
- God then spoke to Joshua and instructed him to have the Israelites gather food for three days and move to the River Jordan. The Lord promised a miracle to enable them to cross the river and reach Canaan.
- Before crossing the River Jordan, God said to Joshua: "Choose twelve men, one from each tribe, and command each to take along on their shoulders a stone from the place where the priests are standing in the river. Tell them to put the stones down where you camp tonight."
- They made camp at Gilgal, east of Jericho, and there, Joshua set up these stones in remembrance of God's help in crossing the river Jordan.
- According to God's will, Jericho was the first city the Israelites were to capture.
- It was surrounded by a strong wall and it seemed impossible to capture this city. But, once again God arranged for a miracle.
- By following God's instructions, Israel also captured the remaining thirty-one cities.
- They could now take possession of Canaan and God's promise was fulfilled.



What does this lesson teach us?

- In John 14: 3, Jesus Christ promises to prepare a place for us in heaven and that He will come again to take us unto Him.
- This promise will be fulfilled and we must prepare for this day when Jesus comes to fetch us.

How do we prepare for the return of Jesus Christ?

- We read and listen to God's word.
- We believe and trust God's word.
- We obey God's word and
- We actively take part in the work of God with love and joy.

Answer: They followed God's exact instructions; God helped them

6. What did Joshua do at Gilgal with the 12 stones?

Answer: He set up a remembrance of God's help in crossing the Jordan river
