Elkanah: I'll be finished with school in two years, but I have to practise my whole life.







Of all the Dead Sea Scrolls found, this one is the best preserved. It consists of 17 leather leaves which have been sewn together to make one strip. The scroll is 7.34 m long, 26 cm high, and rolled up it is 12 cm thick. It was written in Hebrew between 200 and 150 before Christ. It is called Isaiah Scroll because it contains the entire Book of Isaiah.





