THE PARABLE OF THE TEN VIRGINS


Matthew 25:1-13

- 4. but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.
- 5. But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept.
- 6. And at midnight a cry was heard: "Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!"
- 7. Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps.
- 8. And the foolish said to the wise, "Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out."
- 9. But the wise answered, saying, "No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves."
- 10. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut.
- 11. Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, "Lord, Lord, open to us!"
- 12. But he answered and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you."
- 13. Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.


