
JESUS RAISES THE DEAD

Her spirit returned and she stood up immediately.




THE YOUNG MAN OF NAIN

LAZARUS



John 11: 1-44

One day, the Lord Jesus found out through a messenger sent by Martha and Mary that His friend Lazarus had fallen very ill.

Although Jesus loved the two sisters and Lazarus, He did not go to there immediately. Only after two days He set out for Bethany with His disciples. On the way He told them Lazarus had died.

When they came near Bethany, Martha ran toward them. She said that her brother had been lying in the grave for four days. Jesus replied, "Your brother will rise again. I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall he live." Martha believed him. Together they went to the tomb.

There the Lord Jesus had the stone which was in front of it removed, prayed that the Father would hear Him, thanked God for it, and cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth."

Lazarus came out and the linen bandages he had been wrapped with were removed. Then many of the people who had seen the miracle of this raising from the dead believed in Jesus.

a good mood. She was our sunshine. Now we are alone!"


When the servant reaches Jairus, he finds him with Jesus.

What did Jesus say to the dead girl?


Where was the dead young man lying?
