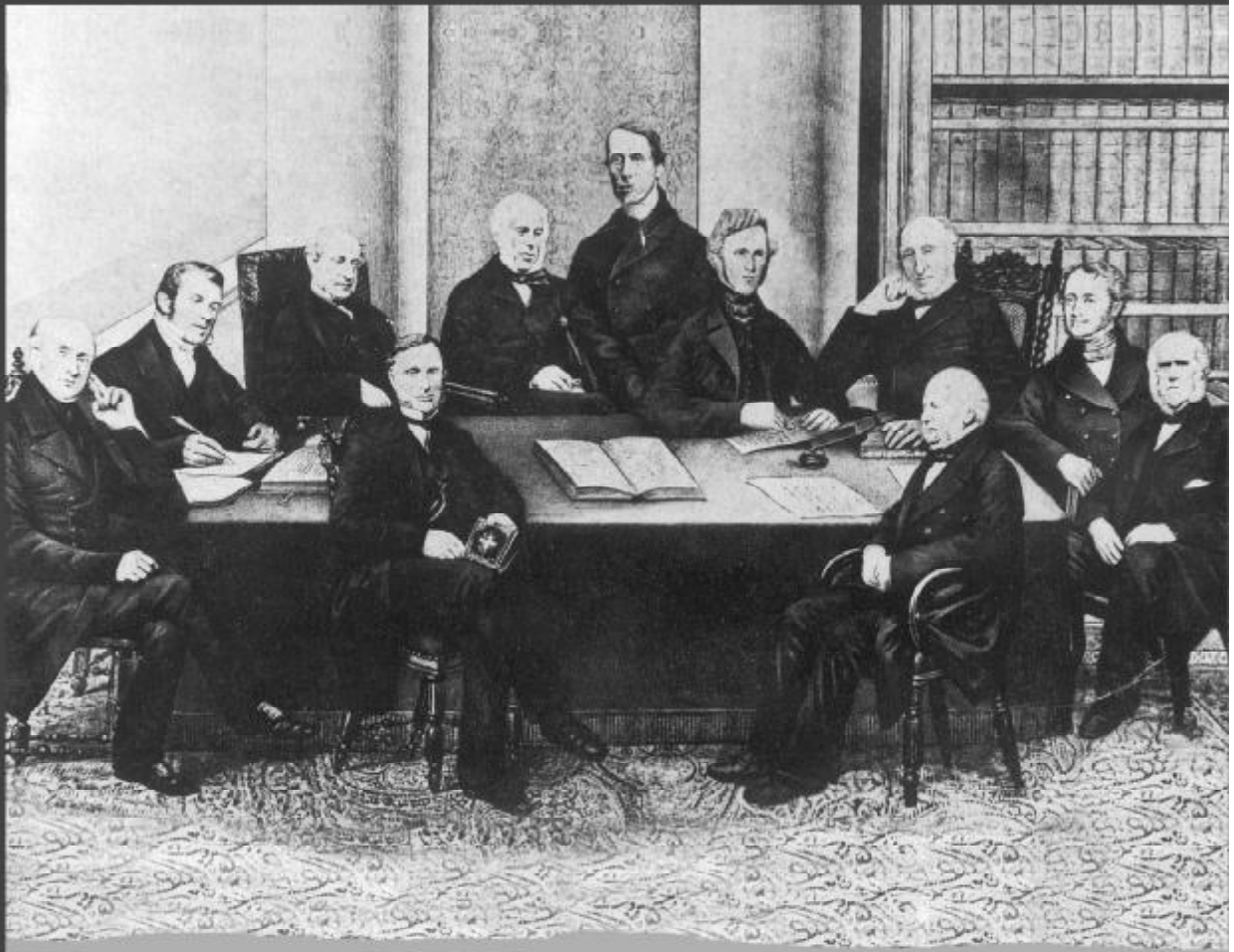

## JOHN BATE CARDALE

### Excerpts from the life of John Bate Cardale

John Bate Cardale was born in London in 1802. He was a respected lawyer and a highly regarded member of his Anglican parish. News of the spiritual gifts which had appeared in Scotland, caused him to travel there in September 1830. He wanted to get an idea about the events himself. His investigation led him to the conviction that these phenomena were actually spiritual gifts.

After his return from Scotland, Cardale arranged regular prayer meetings at his home. When prophecies began to be uttered there as well, Cardale started having differences of opinion with the minister of his parish, such that he and his family transferred to another parish.

In 1832 he joined the London congregation of the Church of Scotland, in which Edward Irving was the pastor. Irving was one of the best known preachers in London, who promoted prophecy and speaking in tongues in his congregation.

The first time that John Bate Cardale was referred to as an Apostle by Henry Drummond was probably on 31 October 1832. A week later, on 7 November 1832, God repeated this calling through the prophet Taplin. The prophet stepped forward and addressed John Bate Cardale as an Apostle of Christ. This call was followed by a prophetic utterance about the Apostle ministry. For the moment, the faithful were surprised and shocked by the Apostle's calling. They thought the Apostle ministry had been reserved for the early church only.

Apostle Cardale later became a pillar among the Apostles. He died in 1877.

## THE CONSECRATION OF THE APOSTLES



By July 1835 another eleven Apostles had been called, in addition to Apostle Cardale. One of them refused the call he had received.

In a gathering on 23 May 1835, a prophetic utterance indicated "that the fourteenth day of the seventh month had been determined by God as the date on which the twelve would be consecrated for their work." However, only eleven Apostles were willing to accept the ministry.

On the evening of 13 July 1835, prior to the significant date, another meeting took place. A prophecy ordered all to remain together throughout the night and pray for the calling of the twelfth Apostle. The prophecy that the Lord had heard their prayers came only when the congregation had gathered during the afternoon of 14 July. The eleven Apostles selected two men. One of them, Duncan Mackenzie, was called as an Apostle through a prophetic utterance.

On 14 July the twelve Apostles came and stood before the Angels of the seven London churches, who laid their hands upon the Apostles and pronounced a blessing on each "for the work, for which the Lord [had] called them". Through their consecration they were released from the work they had been fulfilling in the congregation, and appointed as ambassadors of the Lord for all Christian churches.

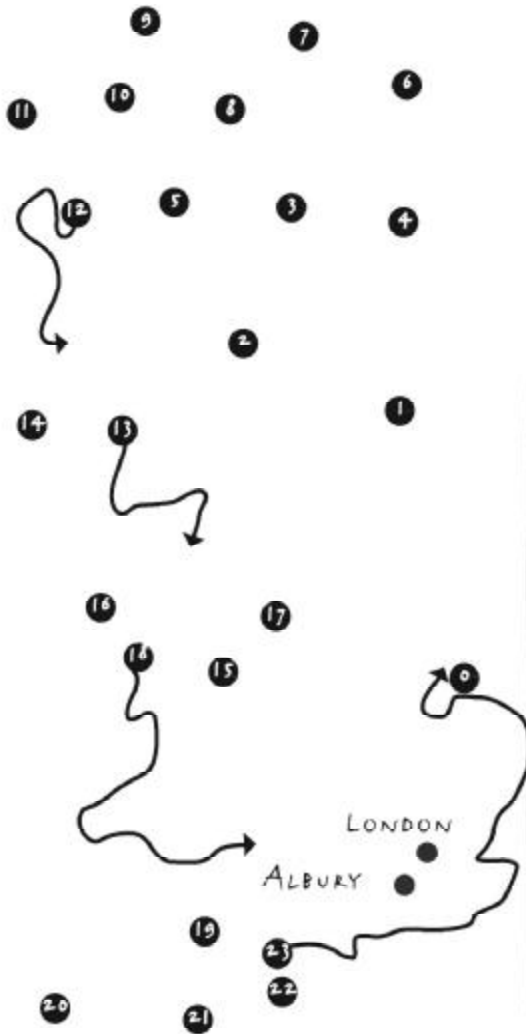
