Below are some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

	Note:	
	2.1: An ideal time preferably to present the lesson is after the Sunday morning service in line with the normal Sunday School time to maintain the routine.	
	2.2: Please keep the lesson as concise (brief) as possible, bearing in mind t attention span (to focus on the lesson) of our children - you know yo child best! Sunday School normally does not exceed 45 minutes.	
	2.3: The lesson is class specific (Confirmation 2).	
	2.4: Please contact your Confirmation Teacher if you need any assistance or if you need any of the above resources.	
3	Pray (see the prayer at the end of this document) and ask God to use you as a tool to present the lesson the way He would want us to present it.

How to prepare and present the lesson

We continue to share some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

Step	Action	
4	Create a pleasant, disturbance free learning environment where you and the child/ren are at the same level.	
	<i>Example:</i> Sit on a mat or around a table.	
5	Read through the lesson. Re-read the lesson so that you understand it.	
	Watch the video-clip of the lesson to get a better understanding of the lesson.	
6	Make notes for yourself on important points that you would like to remember.	
7	Understand the objective of the lesson that your child must remember.	
8	Present the lesson to your child.	
9	Show your child the video and recap on the meaning.	
10	Refer your child to the activity in the child's workbook (I Also Want To)	
11	Pray, or ask your child to pray and close the lesson.

The Lesson

Lesson Title	Friendship, love, and loyalty
Text	• 1 Samuel 16: 12 / 1 Samuel 18 - 20
	• 1 Samuel 20: 17 / Matthew 19: 6
	• John 15: 12-14
Lesson Objective	Our lesson today teaches us that the confirmands are aware that love and loyalty form the basis for a harmonious and trusting relationship.

Lesson Summary:

- Genuine friendship is a relationship which grows between two people.
- It is consolidated through mutual experiences.
- An important quality of genuine friendship is loyalty. Please do yourself a favor and read the bible story about David and Jonathan (1 Samuel 18 20).
- Genuine friendship is not limited to a certain age. It exists among children and young people and adults.
- To be faithful and loyal means having the firm determination to keep one's promises by putting them into action.
- As confirmands we must remember that it is very important before beginning a relationship, we can turn to our heavenly Father in prayer.
- In prayer we ask Him to give us the right thoughts and feelings. Our parents will gladly be available to counsel us.
- We can also speak with our Priest concerning matters close to our heart. He will pray for us so that we will make the correct decision.
- Jesus Christ is perfect in every way because He is without sin. He is the best friend we can have.
- We can therefore always trust Him, tell Him everything and entrust all our concerns to Him.
- He is also the bridegroom of our soul. We wait for Him to take us to Himself so that we will be forever united with Him.



What does this lesson mean for us today?

This lesson taught us that:

We need to be aware that love and loyalty form the basis for a harmonious and trusting relationship. As confirmands, always remember we can turn to our Heavenly, our parents and our ministers for advice.
